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- **GDP Growth:** 8%
- **Exports:** USD 103 billion  
(current growth Apr-Oct-22%)
- **Imports:** USD 149 billion  
Of which, (excluding Oil): USD 97 billion  
(current growth Apr-Oct-29%)
- **Foreign Exchange Reserves:** USD 168 billion (November 2006 )

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**Indian Textile Sector**

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- Contributes about 4% to the GDP
- 14% contribution to total industrial production
- 17% of India's Exports earnings
- Largest Employment provider after Agriculture
- Total market size – US \$ 52 Billion (2006)
  
- **SPINNING:** 34 million spindles
- **WEAVING:** 2 Million looms (excluding handlooms)  
Sector is Poised for Major Growth with modernization & capacity expansion
- **KNITTING:** Large knitting sector
- **APPAREL:** Current Level of Market Size – around US \$ 19 billion

### Home Textile Trade

- Size of the World Home Textile Trade – US \$ 48.25 Bn (of which Home Textiles of Cotton – US \$ 25.16 Bn – share of 59%)
- Trade increased at an Annual Growth of 8.6% from US \$ 17 Bn in 2000 to US \$ 25 Bn in 2004
- Likely to touch US \$ 30 Bn in 2007
- Towels, Drapery, Bed & Table Linen and Cushion Covers together account for a share of 52%
- China, Pakistan and India are the top three suppliers
- China has a share of 20% while India and Pakistan are on par with a share of around 8%

- Raise the market share from 3.4% to 7% in the global textile & clothing trade

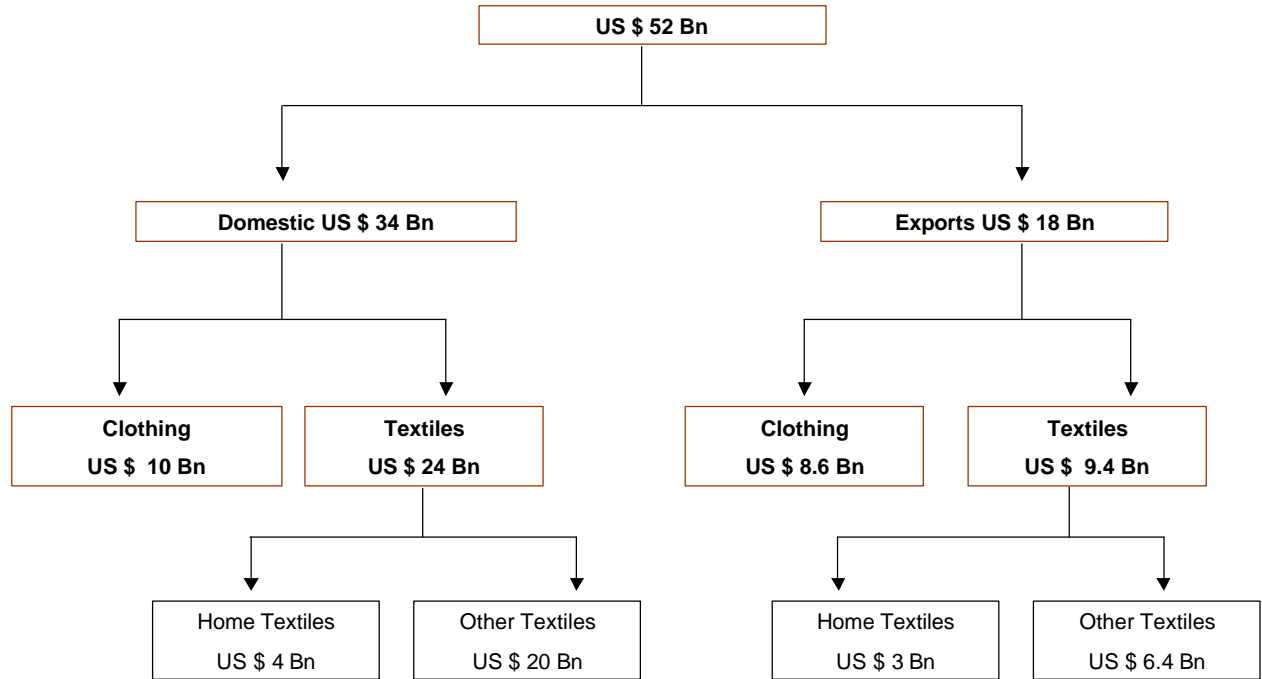


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- Creation of 14 million additional jobs
