


Figure1 The Regional Distribution of Fibers in the World in 2001




Figure 2 The Regional Distribution of World Fiber in 1990




Figure3 Regional Distribution of Cotton in the World in 2001




Figure4 The Regional Distribution of Chemical Fiber in the World in 2001




Figure 5 Regional Distribution of Export Value of Textiles in 2001




Figure 6 The Regional Distribution of Export Value of Garment in 2001
